### Short stay visa for settlement in France as spouse of a citizen from a Union European country (except French citizen)

1/Passport excepted, all documents have to be produced with their French or English translation.  
2/ For each document required the original and a photocopy has to be provided

Documents to be attached (not stapled) and **arranged as specified below** to a long-stay visa application form (completed, dated and signed). *Visa application form can be down loaded on internet : [www.ambafrance-th.org](http://www.ambafrance-th.org)*

• <b>2 colour ID photographs</b> , size, 3,5x4,5 cm, taken recently, against a plain white background.		
• <b>Passport</b> with a validity of at least 3 months beyond the last day of the requested visa.		
• <b>1 copy</b> of the page of the passport with the photograph and those mentioning an extension of validity and changes of name.		
• <b>the marriage certificate</b> : if the marriage was not celebrated in Europe, it has to bear the certification from the European spouse's consular authorities or to be produced with a certificate from the said consular authorities.		
• <b>1 documentary evidence of the nationality of the European spouse</b> : national identity card OR certificate of nationality OR any other official document.		
• <b>1 copy of proofs of the European spouse's residence in France</b> : valid tenancy agreement, or 3 last rent receipts or title of deed or other document confirming the place of residence, <b>or a certificate about the intention of settle in France</b>		
• <b>Letter from the European spouse confirming the settlement in France of his (her) spouse</b>		

#### WARNING

Incomplete applications will be considered like as provided but could result in refusal of the visa.

#### IMPORTANT

With this visa, the applicant can ask for a residence permit at the "Prefecture". This request has to be placed during the 2 months following the entry in France.
